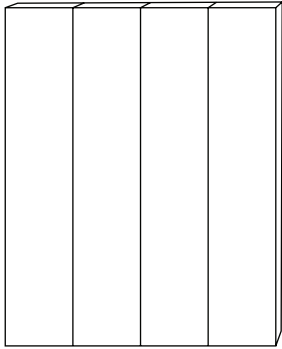
Please Read All Instructions Carefully Before Assembling This Product

- Failure to follow all instructions will result in the product warranty being voided.

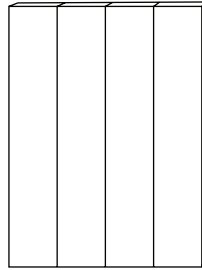

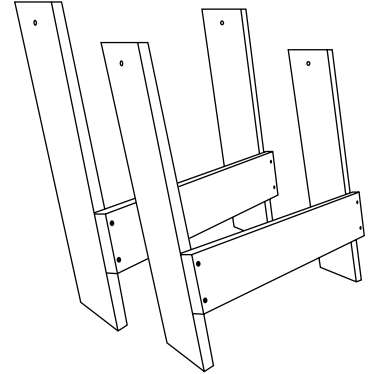
(A) Table Top - 1 piece

(F) Nuts - 4 pieces



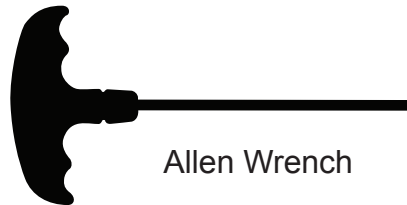
Important: When attaching the nuts, ALWAYS start with the metal part screwing onto the bolt/screw. Starting with the plastic part will not work and may cause the chair not to be properly assembled. See illustration to the right.

Care

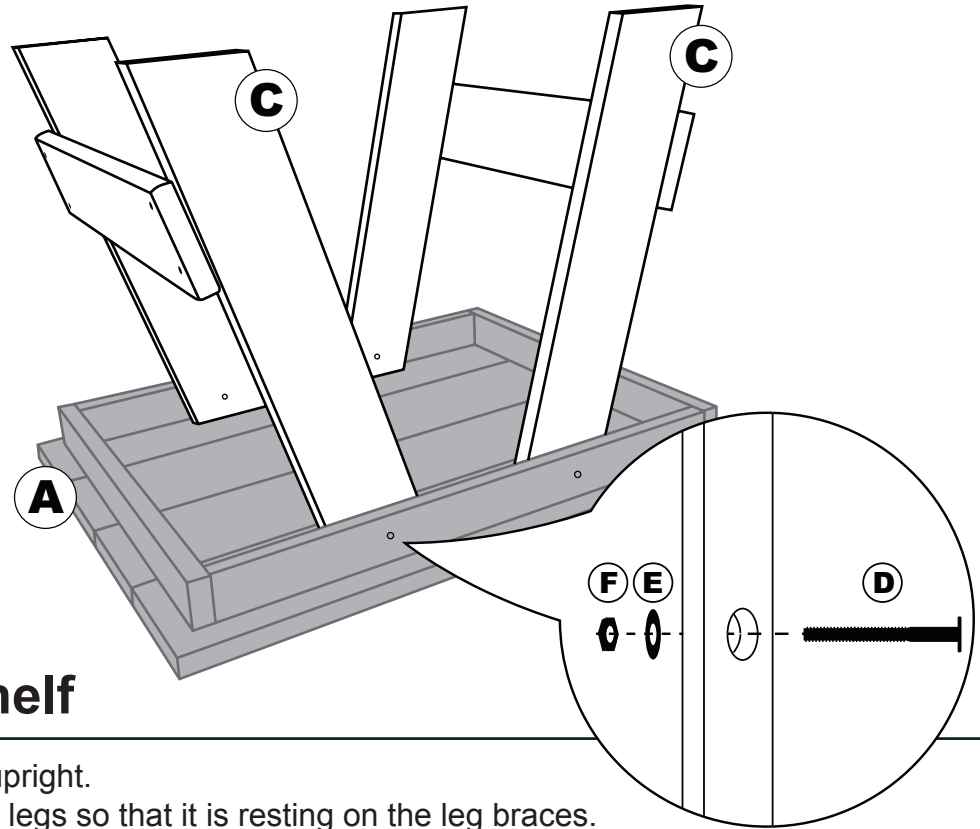
Poly lumber is easy to clean and maintain. Dust with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush, and tend to spills and stains with a mild soap and water. No waterproofing, no staining, and no painting is ever required! **IMPORTANT!** Periodically check to make sure that all screws are properly tightened.

Let's Get Started!

Step 1 - Attaching the Legs

- Start with the bottom of table top (A), facing up.
- Line up the legs (C) with the pre-drilled holes of the top (A), making sure the brace is facing outwards.
- Insert the bolt (D) and tighten on the inside of the leg with a washer (E) and nut (F).



Step 2 - Bottom Shelf

- Flip the table over so it is now upright.
- Place the shelf (B) between the legs so that it is resting on the leg braces.
