Assembly Instructions

Poly Ridge Rocker

Please Read All Instructions Carefully Before Assembling This Product

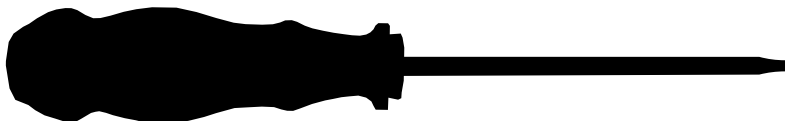
- Inspect all parts to make sure that nothing is broken or missing. If something is broken or missing, please contact our service department at support@eccboutdoor.com.
- The rocker must be completely assembled before attempting to use it. Failure to do so could result in damage to the chair or the user.
- Use proper safety gear and follow appropriate safety precautions when assembling this product.
- **Important - Do not overtighten the screws.**
- Only hand tools should be used for assembly. Do not use power tools.
- ECCB Outdoor will not be liable for any injury or damage resulting from improper assembly and/or use of this product.
- Failure to follow all instructions will result in the product warranty being voided.

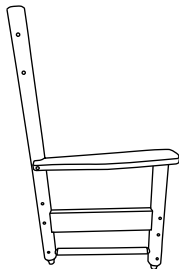

B Arms - 2 pcs



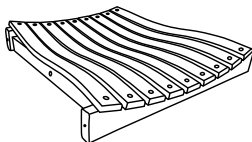
C Front Spindles - 2 pcs



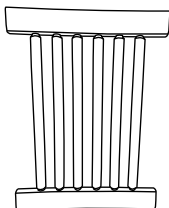
D Back Spindle - 1 pc



E Seat - 1 pc



F Back - 1 pc



Place the back on a flat surface. If the back can be rocked, the side facing up should be placed facing front.

G Top - 1 pc



H Rockers - 2 pcs

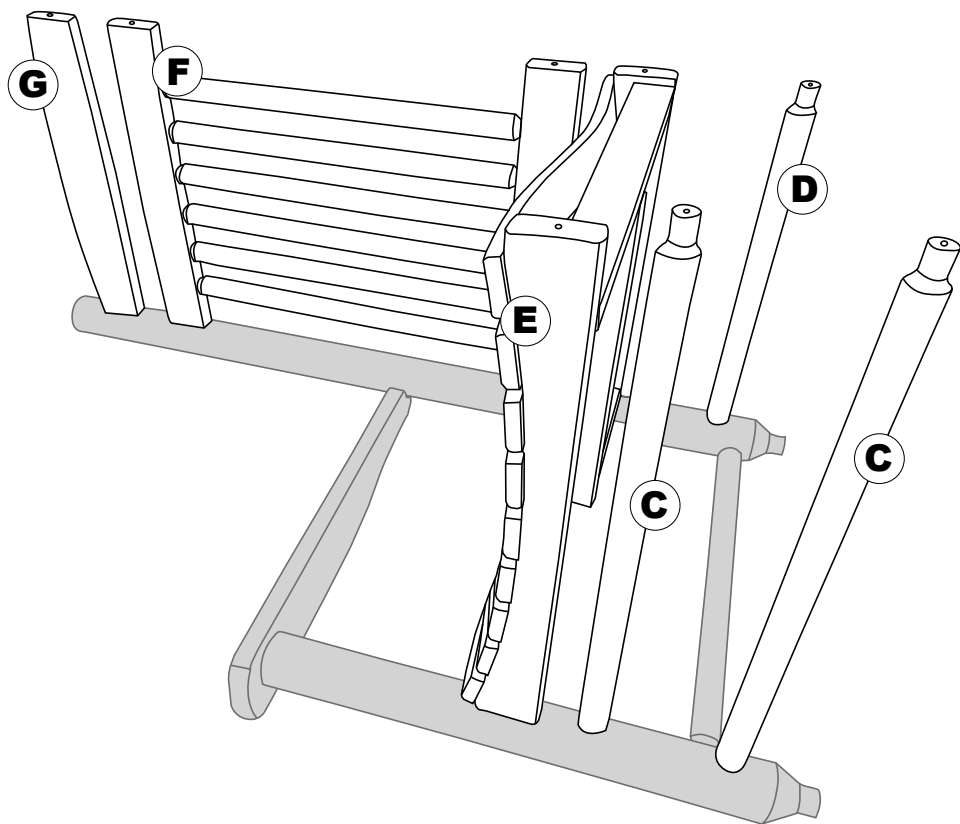


Step 1 - Assembling Side One

- Lay an arm on its side with the pockets facing up. To make this easier, place the arm on a table with the armrest hanging off the edge of the table. You can start this process with either arm.
- Then place the following items into the pockets in this order:

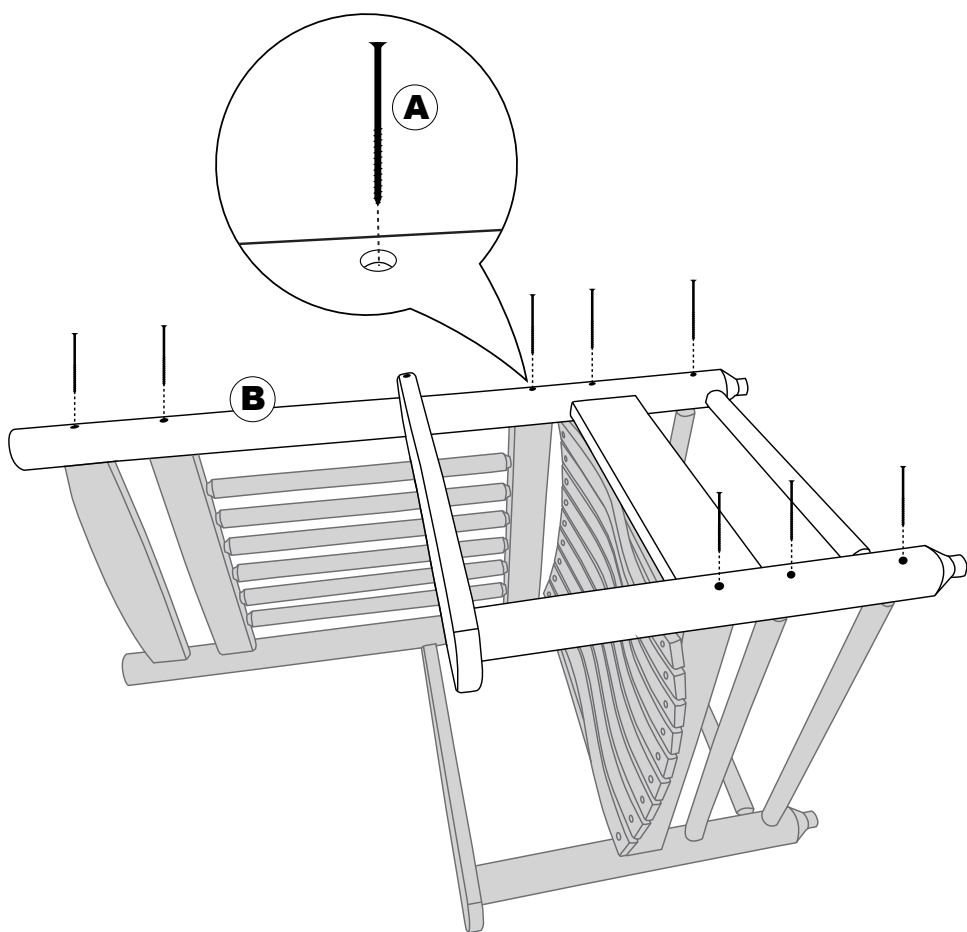
Loosely attach each piece with screws before moving onto the next piece. You will tighten them later in step 3.

- (C) Front Spindles
- (D) Back Spindle - *This one is slightly shorter than the front spindles*
- (E) Seat - *The front of the seat is slightly wider*
- (F) Back - *See previous page to determine the front and back*
- (G) Top - *Make sure the curved part is at the top and the tag is on the back of the rocker*



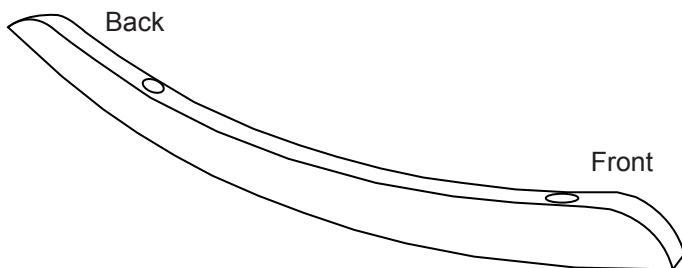
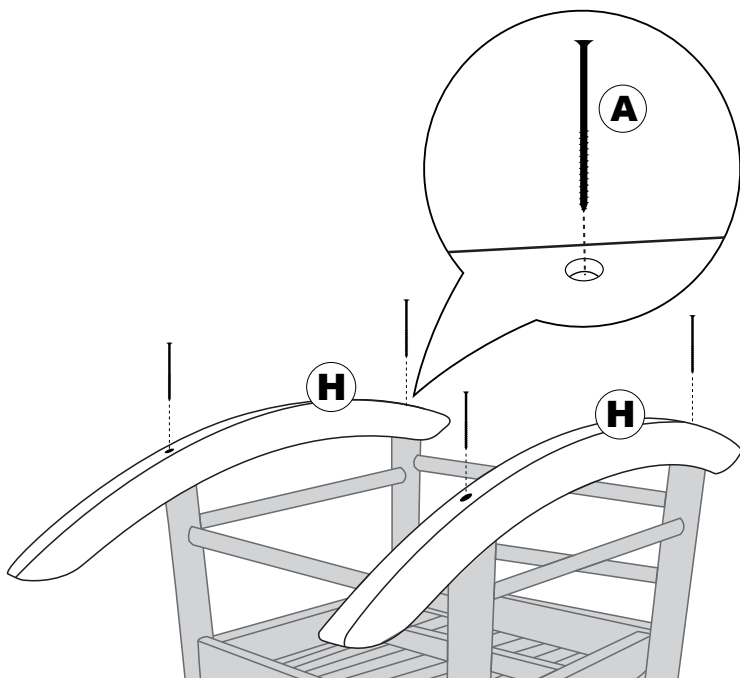
Step 2 - Attaching Side Two

- Flip the rocker over with the unassembled side facing up so that you can attach the second arm (B)
- First insert the spindles into the pockets on the second arm (B)
- Then insert the seat into the pockets and continue moving up the rocker until everything is aligned.
- Begin to attach the arm using the provided screws. These screws can be fully tightened during this step.
- Once side two is all attached - tighten the screws on the other side from Step 1.



Step 3 - Attaching the Rocker Bottoms

- Turn the rocker upside down.
- Attach the rockers (H) to the bottom using the remaining hardware. The front of the rockers have the hole closest to the end. See *bottom illustration*.



Care For Your Rocker

Poly lumber is easy to clean and maintain. Dust with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush, and tend to spills and stains with a mild soap and water. No waterproofing, no staining, and no painting is ever required! IMPORTANT! Periodically check to make sure that all screws are properly tightened.

That's all there is to it and now you have a comfortable rocking chair that we hope you will enjoy. Thank you for your business!
